As part of the implementation of the special play operation of Eintracht Frankfurt

Eintracht Frankfurt Fußball AG, Moerfelder Landstraße 362, D-60528 Frankfurt am Main („Ein-tracht Frankfurt“), together with the Frankfurt am Main Health Authority, has developed a comprehensive concept for the operation of the matches, which, despite the current SARS-CoV-2 pandemic, makes the environment safe enough for the given amount of spectators according to the Health Ministry of Hessen.

In addition to the Corona-related rules of conduct known to you from public life, a visit of the match requires you to answer and sign this health questionnaire

This questionnaire has to be printed out, filled in, signed and handed in at the entrance of the stadium on the day of the match. We kindly ask for your understanding and your help on the way back to normality.

I do not suffer from typical symptoms of an infection with the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2, which is not known to have any other cause, and I have not suffered from such symptoms in the last 14 days either.

Typical symptoms of an infection with the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 are dry cough, fever, shortness of breath, headache, sore throat and limbs, and impaired sense of taste and smell.

There is no current positive detection of the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2.

As far as I know, I have not knowingly had any contact in the last 14 days with a person who has been tested positive for the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2, who is suspected of being infected with the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 or who has stayed in one of the domestic or foreign risk areas defined by the Robert Koch Institute in the last 14 days.

Persons who are in contact with infected persons as a result of their professional activity in health care can still tick this box.

If you do not tick one of the boxes, please understand that, in order to protect the health of the other visitors, we cannot allow you to enter the Deutsche Bank Park.

Please also let us know immediately if there are any changes to the information you have provided (e.g. if you later come to know that you had contact with someone (presumably) infected with the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 before the game or if you discover symptoms yourself up to 14 days after the above-mentioned game). As far as we are legally obliged to do so, we may ask you for further or more detailed information in order to locate and contain the sources of infection and to protect potential contact persons. Such information may include, but is not limited to who you had personal contact with in connection with the above match or the areas of the stadium you were in.

Current information about the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 can be found on the website of the Robert Koch Institute (<https://www.rki.de/EN/>).

With your signature, you confirm that the above information is true and correct and that you are aware that any false statements may have a significant impact on the public health and health situation of the persons in the stadium on the day of the match and their families and personal surroundings.

You also confirm that you are aware that despite the extensive protective measures in place, there is still a residual risk of becoming infected with the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 during your presence in the stadium during the above-mentioned match and that you are aware of this risk. Especially if you belong to one of the risk groups defined by the Robert Koch Institute, you must decide for yourself whether you wish to be present in the stadium during the above-mentioned game.

DATA PROTECTION INFORMATION ACCORDING TO ART. 13 DSGVO

As the responsible party within the context of the European Data Protection Basic Regulation („**DSGVO**“) and the Federal Data Protection Act („**BDSG**“), Eintracht Frankfurt Fußball AG („**EINTRACHT FRANKFURT**“) collects, processes and uses data for the purpose of ensuring that the Bundesliga match („**MATCH**“) specified in the questionnaire is played safely for all participants in compliance with the data protection regulations applicable in the Federal Republic of Germany, in particular the DSGVO and the BDSG, personal data in connection with the signatory's re-sponse to the questionnaire and the admission control to the Deutsche Bank Park on the day of the MATCH.

This data protection information explains which data of the signatory are collected in the course of answering the questionnaire and its verification as well as the entrance control to Deutsche Bank Park on the day of the MATCH and how these data are processed. The undersigned will be informed separately about any other processing of his/her data, e.g. in connection with the purchase of tickets to the MATCH.

1. Which personal data will be collected?

The following data of the signatory will be collected and processed within the framework of the questionnaire: First and last name, company, contact details (e-mail or tele-phone number), details of the MATCH (match day, match) and answers to the questions in the questionnaire.

2. What are the legal bases and the purposes for which this data is processed?

The signatory's personal data will only be processed if a legal basis from the DSGVO, the BDSG or any other applicable data protection standard allows this. The processing is based in particular on the following legal bases:

- To the extent that the processing is carried out for the fulfilment of a legal obligation to which the controller concerned is subject, Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 c) DSGVO, and, to the extent that the processing involves health-related data, Art. 9 para. 2 i) DSGVO; and
- to the extent that the processing is necessary to protect legitimate interests and does not override the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the undersigned, Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) DSGVO, and, to the extent that the processing involves health-related data, Art. 9 para. 2 f) and i), Art. 22 para. 1 no. 1 c) BDSG

2.1 Compliance with legal obligations, Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 c) DSGVO, Art. 9 para. 2 i) DSGVO

As far as Eintracht Frankfurt is legally obliged to do so, it will inform the responsible public health department in case of suspected or proven infection of the undersigned or a contact person of the undersigned with the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 in order to support the responsible public health department in tracing and containing possible sources of infection and to discuss further actions. This data transfer is justified under Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 c) DSGVO, Art. 9 para. 2 i) DSGVO.

2.2 Protection of legitimate interests, Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) DSGVO, Art. 9 para. 2 f) and i) DSGVO, Art. 22 para. 1 no. 1 c) BDSG

In order to ensure the health and safety of all persons pre-sent in the Deutsche Bank Park for the MATCH (spectators, staff, etc.), their re-

latives and their personal environment, as well as for reasons of public interest to protect against serious cross-border health risks, Eintracht Frankfurt processes the information from the questionnaire in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) DSGVO, Art. 9 para. 2 i) DSGVO, Art. 22 para. 1 no. 1 c) BDSG. The measures for the implementation of the special-purpose play with restricted admission of spectators were agreed with the competent authorities (e.g. Federal Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs and Federal Ministry of Health and in particular the Frankfurt Health Authority).

Eintracht Frankfurt will retain the completed and signed questionnaire until any claims that the signatory might assert due to the use of his personal data have become time-barred. Retention is justified in order to safeguard the legitimate interest of those responsible in being able to prove that the admission control was carried out properly and that the signatory has received comprehensive data protection information in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) DSGVO and to assert, exercise and defend possible legal claims in accordance with Art. 9 para. 2 f) DSGVO.

3. To whom will the signatory's data be transmitted?

3.1 The signatory will forward the filled-in questionnaire to Eintracht Frankfurt. Eintracht Frankfurt will keep the questionnaire in its custody.

3.2 If the signatory is suspected of being infected or even proven to be infected with the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2, Eintracht Frankfurt will forward the data to the responsible public health office on the instruction of the latter for the purpose of locating and containing the sources of infection.

3.3 Personal data of the signatory will otherwise only be passed on if required by legal regulations or official decrees.

4. How long are the signatory's personal data stored?

All data is deleted when it is no longer required for the purposes for which it was collected. As a rule, the personal data collected with this questionnaire will be deleted no later than four weeks after it was collected, unless Eintracht Frankfurt is obliged to store the data for a longer period of time by law.

5. Rights of the signatory

5.1 Rights of the signatory: According to the DSGVO, the signatory is entitled to certain rights, in particular a right to be informed about the personal data stored about him (Art. 15 DSGVO), Correction of incorrect data (Art. 16 DSGVO), deletion of data (subject to the conditions of Art. 17 DSGVO), restriction of processing (Art. 18 DSGVO), data transferability in accordance with Art. 20 DSGVO; and objection to processing insofar as it is carried out to safeguard legitimate interests (Art. 21 DSGVO). In addition, there is a right of appeal to the competent data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 DSGVO).
