## MESSAGE FROM UEFA PRESIDENT



We are delighted to welcome you to the Helsinki Olympic Stadium for the 2022 UEFA Super Cup match. The Finnish capital is the setting for the first UEFA club competition final to be played in Finland.

This Super Cup match is an exciting curtain-raiser to the new club competition season, bringing together the winners of the 2021/22 UEFA Champions League, Real Madrid, and UEFA Europa League, Eintracht Frankfurt. UEFA decided several years ago to take the Super Cup around Europe, and Finland is the latest of our member associations to have the opportunity to play host to this major international football occasion.

The stadium in Helsinki was built to host the Summer Olympic Games that eventually took place in 1952, and underwent major renovations from 2016 to 2020. Its distinct tower stands 72.71 metres high – the distance thrown by Finnish athlete Matti Järvinen to bring him the javelin gold medal at the 1932 Summer Olympics in Los Angeles. The arena is also home to Finland's national football team.

We expect a hard-fought encounter between two teams packed with players of the highest quality. I hope that you will witness a match to remember – and enjoy your stay in Helsinki.



## TRAVELLING TO HELSINKI BY PLANE



The best airport to travel to is Helsinki Airport (HEL): <a href="https://www.finavia.fi/en/airports/helsinki-airport">https://www.finavia.fi/en/airports/helsinki-airport</a>



You can also fly to Tampere (TMP) or Turku (TKU) Airports and come to Helsinki by train arriving at Helsinki main railway station close to the stadium and city center.



#### TRAVEL TIPS



 Travel light. If you are traveling by charter flight, no checked baggage is allowed. Bags are not allowed in the stadium (2 bag deposits will be available in the immediate surroundings of the stadium). Please see the stadium information section for more details.



• For charter flight departures, you must already have your boarding pass printed.



 You can be at the stadium from 19:00, when the gates open, if you don't want to miss any of the pre-match ceremony.



### **INDIVIDUAL TRAVELERS**



You can reach the city center from Helsinki Airport by Public Transport via train lines "I" and "P" (trains going opposite directions, duration 30min). Please download the HSL Application for information and ticket purchase:

### **ORGANISED GROUPS**

Tour operators can organise coaches for charter flights arriving at Helsinki Airport on matchday. ### FAN MEETING POINTS



Fan Meeting points will be in urban squares and parks, conveniently located at walking distance to the stadium, the fan festival and the city's main attractions.



Fans will find food and beverage facilities, toilets, and transport information at the fan meeting points, which are surrounded by many bars and restaurants.



The specified transport mode will take you directly to your allocated entrance from the Fan Meeting point.



Please follow all instructions that you receive from staff and volunteers at your fan meeting point as well as at the transport hubs.













#### **EINTRACHT FRANKFURT SUPPORTERS**

- Fan Meeting Point at Kaisaniemenpuisto for all supporters.
- Eintracht Frankfurt supporters landing at Helsinki Airport are recommended to use Helsinki Public Transport and travel from the airport to the city centre by train. Kaisaniemenpuisto, where the The Fan Meeting Point is located, is right next to the Helsinki Central Railway Station.
- Onward travel to the stadium is possible via a scenic walking route, which takes approximately 30min (only 2 km). Alternatively, supporters can head to tram stop Rautatieasema (2 or 2B) or Lasipalatsi (4 or 10) and travel to Ooppera stop.
- Non-ticketed supporters are invited to go to the Fan Festival area for the Fan Viewing of the match.
- The timetable of the trains going to the airport has been prolonged and those traveling back to the airport postmatch will be able to return to the airport by train. #### **REAL MADRID SUPPORTERS**

- REAL MADRID supporters (organized groups) landing at Helsinki Airport via chartered flight will be brought by their associated charter coaches to the load zone called Vauhtitie near the Helsinki Olympic Stadium. From there it is a 5-minute walk to the stadium.
- Fan Meeting Point at Narinkkatori in the city center (no facilities but many bars and restaurants close by)
- Non-ticketed supporters are invited to go to the Fan Festival area for the Fan Viewing of the match.
- Those traveling by charter coach back to the airport post-match will be able to meet their coaches on the same load zone called Vauhtitie near the stadium.
- Individual travelers can go straight to the Helsinki Central Railway Station. The timetable of the trains going to the airport has been prolonged and it is possible to return to the airport post-match also by train. 








#### **KEY SPECTATOR LOCATIONS MAP**






### **GETTING TO** THE STADIUM











If you are using the tram, there are two tram stops very close to the stadium. To access Entrances South, East 1 and East 2 it is recommended to use Ooppera tram stop (trams 2, 2B, 4 and 10). To access Entrance North the closest tram stop is Kansaneläkelaitos (only trams 4 & 10).

















If you are using public transportation, you must purchase your ticket before entering the vehicle. It is recommended to download the HSL Application. Via the HSL App you can purchase tickets and use the Journey Planner which shows you the mode of transport and the timetable from your location to your preferred destination. You can find the HSL App from Apple Store and Google Play.

### **ACCESSIBLE SERVICES FOR DISABLED SPECTATORS**



UEFA does its utmost to ensure all its competitions are accessible.



Wheelchair users should go to Entrance East 2.



 There is a taxi drop point is in front of Entrance East 2, which can be accessed via Hammarskjöldintie road.



• If needed, there are lifts available inside the stadium seating areas



 Accessible services are located nearby concessions stands.



 Audio-descriptive commentary (ADC) is available in both playing team languages



 Access to dedicated stands for seating on the same level of entrance gates.



 Lower serving counters are located on the centre of concessions stands.



Accessible toilets are available throughout the stadium.



Guide and assistance dogs are permitted into the stadium.

### WHEELCHAIR LOAN SERVICE

If required, spectators with reduced mobility / temporary injury can use a wheelchair loan service. Please speak with the volunteers at Entrance East 2 for more information.
















Your QR code will be unveiled at the stadium, when presenting your Mobile Ticket to the steward.

### SAFETY & SECURITY



#### **ALLOW PLENTY OF TIME**



Please allow plenty of time for your journey to the stadium. We recommend you arrive early to avoid queuing. Gates will be open three hours before kickoff. Everyone entering the stadium must be in possession of a valid ticket and will be subject to searching by stewards.



#### **BAGS**



Please note that any bag bigger than A4 size (210mmx 297mm x 210mm) will not be permitted inside the Stadium.



#### **SECURITY**



In order to keep everyone safe, certain items and personal conduct deemed unacceptable are not permitted within the Stadium. Please refer to the prohibited items and conduct information.













#### **ADVICE FROM POLICE AND STEWARDS**



Please follow the advice from police and stewards. They are present to make your experience as enjoyable and safe as possible. Please note that any unacceptable conduct may result in arrest by police or ejection from the stadium.



### GUESTS REQUIRING SPECIAL ASSISTANCE



Supporters who may require assistance entering the stadium or require specific facilities inside the stadium are kindly requested to approach a steward at the entrance gates in order that your needs can be catered for.



### DEPARTING THE STADIUM



















It is recommended to plan for your departure from the stadium and onward travel before the end of the match. Public transport services will be enhanced to allow for all spectators to depart the stadium and reach their destination. Helsinki Olympic Stadium is conveniently located near the city center. The easiest and quickest way back to the city center may be on foot. If you are using the tram line, it is recommended to:

 Use Kansaneläkelaitos or Ooppera stops for traveling back to the Fan Meeting Points and the Helsinki Central Railway station.

The timetable of the trains going to the airport has been prolonged and those traveling back to the airport postmatch will be able to return to the airport also by train. Please check the tram and train timetables on the HSL App.
